Argumentation

Arguments

- ▲ Proofs offered to support claims
- * must back up with good reasoning and evidence

ARE

Assertion (statement)

- ▲ begins argument
- ▲ claim something is true without providing reason or evidence

Reasoning (because)

- ▲ supports each assertion
- A provides explanation why audience should believe claim
- Iinked to assertion

Evidence

- ▲ completes argument
- ▲ backs up statement and reasoning
 - 1. example or illustration
 - 2. form an analogy-true in one situation will be true in similar one
 - 3. statistical data-survey or poll
