




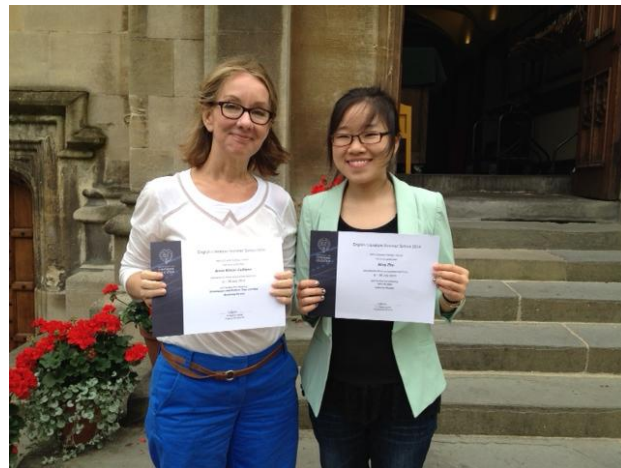

Intensive Programs

- Specifically geared towards teachers
- Graduate-level courses
 - Shakespeare's Globe, London
 - University of Edinburgh
 - University of Oxford
- Taught by institution-based faculty and practitioners
- Scholarship-eligible to encourage educators to apply with the support of their community
- 60-year tradition with the ESU (formerly known as BUSS)

 - Oxford - *deadline Feb. 27*
 - Creative Writing (July 23-Aug.12)
 - English Literature (July 2-22)
 - History, Politics & Society (July 2-22)
 - International Politics (July 30-Aug. 12)
 - Globe (June 26-July 14) - *deadline March 6*
 - Edinburgh - *deadline March 10*
 - Text and Context (July 10-Aug. 19, dates vary)
 - Creative Writing (July 10-Aug. 19, dates vary)
 - Theater and Performance (Aug. 7-19)

One-week Programs

- Open to educators, ESU members, friends, family, community
- One-week educational courses in the UK
 - RADA, London (March 20-24)
 - Shakespeare's Globe, London (June 19-23)
 - University of Oxford (July 16-22)
 - Shakespeare Birthplace Trust, Stratford-upon-Avon (Nov. 19-25)
- Not eligible for ESU branch scholarships
- Starting at £995
- New in 2017, including expansion outside of the previous summer-only model



One-week programs: how to apply

- Simple application online
 - Complete form
 - Deposit payable by check or online with PayPal
 - [RADA](#) - deadline Jan. 24 → *extended to Jan. 27*
 - [Globe](#) - deadline Apr. 15
 - [Oxford](#) - deadline Apr. 15
- Invoice for program sent 10 weeks in advance; conversion set from £ to \$
- Balance due (less deposit) 8 weeks in advance
- Not eligible for ESU scholarship, but applicant may pursue their own funds



Information for Educators

- Professional Development and Licensing/Certification Credit
 - Participants receive certificate of attendance upon completing program
 - Contact and tuition hours provided for all courses/programs
 - University of Edinburgh will award graduate credit for modest fee
- Connection to Pedagogy
 - Participants gain access to professional network in order to connect course content to curricula/classrooms
