Elí and Jody Dow are the proud owners for 50 years of this unique French chateau style house built in 1922-24 by the prominent architect Emil Coulon, who was also responsible for the Vendome, Puritan and Lenox boutique hotels.

From 1928 to 1938 the house was occupied by the Sanfords of Maine – makers of Sanforized cloth. The Ward family bought the house in 1938, but were forced to move out in 1944 when during WWII they could not receive sufficient fuel from the ration board to heat the home. Bing Crosby was a guest of the Wards when he visited in the late 1930s, as he and Mr Ward attempted to buy the Boston Braves. The actress, Cyd Charisse, was also known to "cut-a-rug" as a guest of the Wards.

The Dows have frequently opened their beautiful home for many charitable events, perhaps most memorably an event honoring Arthur Feidler and the Boston Pops.

The proceeds from this annual garden party, our major fundraiser, are to benefit the ESU Education Fund, which supports the Shakespeare Competition for high school students. More than 20,000 talented teenagers from schools in the Greater Boston area have participated in this annual educational event over the last 30 years.
