Dr. Jerry Schiffhorst, we celebrate you!

Dr. Gerald (Jerry) Schiffhorst has been involved with the Central Florida ESU for many years, beginning in 1980, when he received a scholarship for summer study in England. He chose Oxford and studied T. S. Eliot, whose life and work became a topic years later for one of Jerry's many presentations to our chapter. He has done five other ESU talks, including the recent webinar on the Royal Art Collection for the ESU's National Happy Hour Series. He has given twelve other presentations on history at the University Club, all of these after his retirement from the University of Central Florida, where he is a Professor Emeritus of English. He also served as a judge for two of the annual Shakespeare Competitions.

Jerry, who taught literature and writing at UCF for 33 years, found in the ESU an ideal place to keep learning after retirement and to explore his interest in English history. He is greatly impressed by the chapter's commitment to education and area teachers. Dr. Jerry served for two years on the Program Committee as Secretary and continues to be a consultant on speakers, a sort of talent scout. During the pandemic Professor Jerry reached out to various potential presenters, many of whom agreed to do remote (and later in person) talks. Clearly, the Central Florida ESU has long been an important part of his life!
