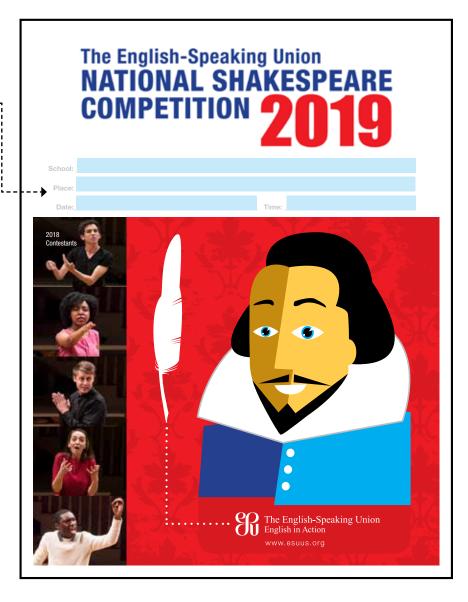
# The English-Speaking Union **NATIONAL SHAKESPEARE COMPETITION SCHOOL POSTER**

An easy to use, fillable PDF of the NSC School Poster has been provided for your use. The aim is to help you promote the competition while retaining a consistent look & feel across all print materials produced by participating schools, by ESU Branches, and at the national level.

File name: SCHOOL POSTER\_letter size.pdf

- PDF has preset fillable sections (shown here in light blue) for: School, Place, Date, Time.
- Simply open the provided **PDF file** and fill in the blank sections with your school's specific information.
- Save the PDF before printing as needed at 100%.

Note: Since office printers typically cannot print to the paper edge, the PDF has been built to  $8.5 \times 11$  with a 1/4" white border.

### To create a poster acknowledging supporters\* of your school competition, please follow these steps:

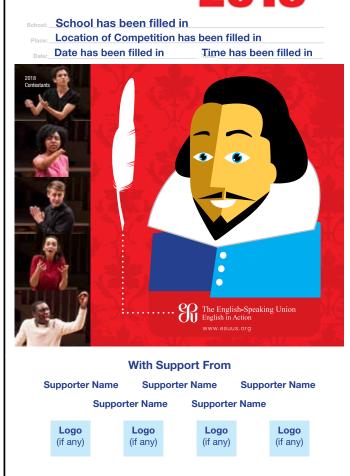
- 1. Open the **PDF file** provided and fill in the blanks (school, place, date, time) with your information.
- 2. Use "Save As" to save the document as a **JPEG file.**
- 3. Then, in **Word** or **Google Docs**, create a new document and set the paper size to 8.5" X 14" (legal size).
- 4. Insert the poster JPEG that you just created at the top of your new legal size document. You will have a 3" blank space at the bottom in which to create a text box.
- 5. Following the type guidelines below type out "**With support from**..." and list the supporter names and logos (if any) of your competition supporters.

#### \*Please note:

The competition is *sponsored* by the ESU. Any additional partners or contributors should be referred to as *supporters*.

6. Save the document and then print copies as needed at 100%.
