Your statement should give evidence of your writing abilities, maturity, motivation, and your adaptability to new circumstances. How do your objectives for studying abroad compare to the ESU's mission and objectives? How will you apply the personal experience of British culture when you return home? You will be required to write papers which will be graded by the institution you select. Your statement should reflect your ability and willingness to write such papers.
