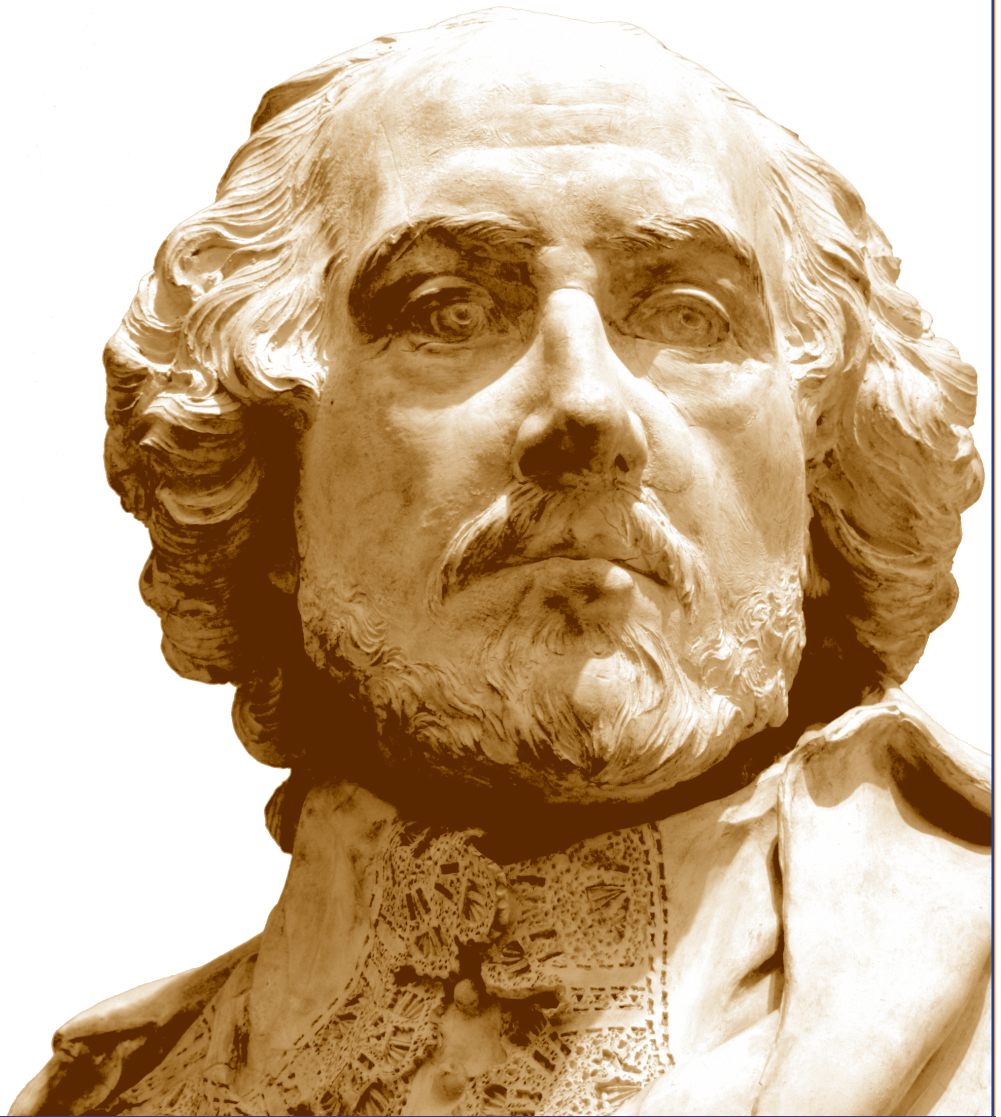


Darren Freebury-Jones is a lecturer in Shakespeare Studies
