*WHAT IS THE SCHOLARSHIP?*

The Richmond Branch of the English-Speaking Union awards scholarships to Richmond area high school teachers for summer study at the University of Oxford, the International Shakespeare Globe Centre in London or the Scottish Universities International Summer School in Edinburgh.

*WHEN IS THE SCHOLARSHIP?*

June-August 2024 (exact dates vary)

*WHO IS ELIGIBLE?*

Richmond area high school teachers with three (3) years of teaching experience are eligible. Most applicants teach English, Social Studies, History and/or Drama.

*WHEN MUST I APPLY?*

Applications must be received no later than Thursday, January 25, 2024.

If you don't already have application materials, contact your Principal, English Chair or Social Studies Chair.
